The phonetic alphabetic characters with diacritics as used in *Grammata Serica* and *Grammata Serica* Recensa are all contained in the Grammata Serica font. Their key assignments are as follows, where the upper-case character is above the key and the lower-case character beneath it.

Short vowels like \check{a} and \hat{q} and palatal obstruents like \hat{t} and \acute{s} are case-shifted from the corresponding letters without diacritics, $a\ \hat{a}\ t\ s$.
